CITIZENSHIP CREDIT "SERVICE FOR OTHERS" EXAMPLES

The following listing is intended to help students/parents know what types of activities are acceptable as "service for others." The listing is not intended to be all inclusive: (All service for others must be uncompensated)

- * Delivering Meals On Wheels
- * Ushering for church services
- * Participating in a food/clothing project for charity
- * Volunteering at a hospital
- * Visiting a senior's care center
- * Visiting with residents
- * Helping with recreation program
- * Reading to residents
- * Performing (outside of normal school hours) for residents of a senior care center
- * Teaching/Assisting Sunday School
- * Assisting with benefit dinners/breakfasts (Legion Club, Community Club, Lion Club, etc.)
- * Singing with church choir
- * Tutoring seriously ill or seriously injured student (special circumstance requiring principal's advanced approval)
 - Helping a "neighbor in need" (mowing, shoveling, cleaning garage)
 Usually for an elderly or ill individual. If in doubt, see principal for advanced approval.
- Participating in an environment project (community clean-up, parks restoration, etc.)
- * Performing custodial work for church
- * Shopping for a shut-in
- * Playing the organ/piano/bells/other instrument for the church
- * Volunteering at a non-profit preschool
- * Assisting with bloodmobile service
