

INTERNET APPROPRIATE USE VIOLATION NOTICE

Students who access restricted items on the Internet shall be subject to the appropriate action described in the school's discipline policy or student handbook or to the following consequences:

First Offense:

The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material. He/she may lose Internet access for up to ten (10) school days at the discretion of the supervising teacher. A second offense will result in the student losing Internet access for a period of twenty (20) school days.

Second Offense:

The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material for a second time. As a consequence of this violation the above student has lost Internet access for a period of twenty (20) school days.

Third Offense:

The above student has violated the Student Internet Policy by intentionally accessing restricted material for a third time. As a consequence of this violation the above student has forfeited all Internet privileges for the balance of the school year.
